Encapsulation Technology: Fluid Bed

FORMYL is a microgranule consisting of calcium formate and citric acid encapsulated using a proprietary fluid bed process that provides a targeted release in the small intestine.

Application Guidelines

- Swine: Use at a rate of 4 - 11 lbs per ton of complete feed.

Packaging and Conditioning

25 kg bags.

When stored in a cool and dry place in the original package, this product is stable for 24 months.
