MAPA ORDINANCE No. 828, OF AUGUST 19, 2025

Approves the Regulation for the award of the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal", within the scope of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock.

THE SUBSTITUTE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK, in the use of the power conferred upon him by art. 87, sole paragraph, item II, of the Constitution, based on item III of art. 1 of Decree No. 8,851, of September 20, 2016, and in view of the provisions of Decree No. 9,203, of November 22, 2017, amended by Decree No. 9,901, of July 8, 2019, and what is contained in Process No. 21000.119001/2022-11, resolves:

Art. 1º The Regulation for the Award of the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal", related to the biennium 2025-2026, is hereby approved within the scope of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock, aimed at agribusiness companies, regulated within the scope of this Ministry, which are recognized as developing good practices of integrity, ethics, social responsibility and environmental sustainability, as provided for in this Ordinance and in Annexes I, II, III and IV.

Art. 2 The management of the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" award and the respective selection process will be conducted by the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee and its Executive Secretariat, in accordance with the attributions established in Ordinance No. 599, of April 16, 2018.

Art. 3 The estimated schedule for completing the stages of the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" is set out in Annex IV.

Art. 4 MAPA Ordinance No. 542, of December 28, 2022, is hereby revoked.

Art. 5 This Ordinance shall come into force on the date of its publication.

ANNEX I

REGULATIONS FOR THE "AGRO MAIS INTEGRIDADE 2025-2026" AWARD

CHAPTER I

PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

Art. 1 The "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" is an initiative promoted by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock, with the support of partner institutions, which aims to reward agribusiness companies, regulated under this Ministry, that stand out in the development of good practices of integrity, ethics, social responsibility and environmental sustainability, with the objective of:

I - encourage the implementation of integrity and ethics programs, in their broad spectrum, considering anti-corruption, social responsibility and environmental sustainability approaches;

II - raise awareness among agribusiness companies about their important role in combating unfair or unintelligible competitive practices;

III - recognize the integrity and ethical practices implemented by companies agribusiness in the national market; and

IV - reduce the risks of fraud and corruption in relations between the public sector and the private sector linked to the practice of agribusiness.

§ 1º For the purposes of this Regulation, the following shall be considered:

I - company - used to generically designate all simple and complex business corporations, provided they are personified, associations of entities or people, cooperatives, and foreign corporations, regularly constituted and which have headquarters, branches or representation in Brazilian territory and which are dedicated to agricultural practices of any nature, this being the target audience of the "Agro Seal More Integrity 2025-2026"; and

II - cooperatives - individual cooperatives and central cooperatives or federations of cooperatives, as provided for in Law No. 5,764 of December 16, 1971.

§ 2º For the purposes of the award referred to in this Regulation, companies outside the productive activity of agribusiness are not included, especially those that do not demonstrate added value to agricultural raw materials, as they are only linked to commercial, laboratory activities not accredited by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock, logistics, storage or Technology.

§ 3 The "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" is not a certifying nature.

§ 4º The award referred to in the caput will not generate any rights, guarantees or obligations for the company. privileges in their relations with the public sector, unless specifically provided otherwise.

§ 5 The "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" implementation cycle is biannual and includes:

I - registrations;

II - documentary assessment of registered companies;

III - communication of the results of the assessments to the companies;

IV - reconsideration phase and appeals filed by non-approved companies; and

V - disclosure of the result.

CHAPTER II

REGISTRATION

Art. 2º The company interested in participating in the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" award process must register during the period to be announced at the electronic address <https://www.gov.br/pt-br/servicos/realizar-inscricao-para-obter-o-selo-mais-integridade>, and in accordance with the guidelines available at that electronic address.



Sole paragraph. Representatives of interested companies must complete the respective registration by completing the form available at the electronic address referred to in the caput, attaching all documentation in the required format and in Portuguese.

Art. 3 To register, interested companies must complete the Evaluation Form, attaching all supporting documents, as set out in Chapter III.

Art. 4. Legal entities may participate in the registration process as head offices or branches, subject to the following situations:

I - the parent company may register directly, without the need for additional authorization;

II - branches may register, provided they present a specific authorization form issued by the respective head office, which must be attached to the registration documentation;

III - if both the head office and one or more of its branches wish to participate, they must register independently, separately detailing the activities performed by each establishment;

IV - the authorization of the head office for the participation of the subsidiary must clearly specify the scope of action permitted to the branch within the scope of the process; and

V - each person registered in the National Registry of Legal Entities - CNPJ, whether from the head office or a branch, will be individually evaluated based on good practices of integrity, ethics, social responsibility and environmental sustainability, in accordance with the Evaluation Requirements set out in Chapter III.

Art. 5 Central cooperatives or federations of cooperatives may only compete for the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" in their own name.

Art. 6. Applications from companies will not be accepted:

I - carried out outside the deadline published on the website <https://www.gov.br/pt-br/services/register-to-obtain-the-most-integrity-seal>;

II - state-owned companies of any sphere of government; and

III - included in the following negative records:

a) registry of Unsuitable and Suspended Companies - CEIS; and

b) National Registry of Punished Companies - CNEP;

IV - that appear on the Dirty List of Slave or Slave-Like Labor provided for in current legislation of the Ministry of Labor and Employment; and

V - who are responding to an Administrative Accountability Proceeding - PAR or participating in negotiations to enter into a Leniency Agreement as referred to in Law No. 12,846, of August 1, 2013, or being monitored by the Comptroller General of the Union - CGU, due to a Leniency Agreement entered into.

Sole paragraph. The criteria established in the caput are eliminatory in nature and are not subject to appeal.

Art. 7. Controlled and subsidiary companies belonging to economic groups must prove the application of the Integrity Program in their own organizational structure, and evidence of application that identifies or mentions only the holding company or another company in the group will not be accepted, except in cases where the item evaluated is applicable exclusively to the holding company.

CHAPTER III

EVALUATION REQUIREMENTS

Art. 8 The integrity program analysis process will be carried out based on the information and documents sent by the company through the Assessment Form, which is divided into three thematic focuses:

I - anti-corruption;

II - social responsibility; and

III - environmental sustainability.

Art. 9 From an anti-corruption perspective, the company must prove:

I - the existence of a regularly and effectively implemented Integrity Program, containing:

a) the definition of the unit or area responsible for its management, with formally assigned duties established and approved by senior management; and

b) demonstration of commitment to the implementation, support and supervision of the said program, upon presentation of documents that demonstrate active participation in such processes;

II - the existence of a code of ethics or conduct approved by the Company's senior management:

a) with wide dissemination to the internal public (via intranet or direct mailing specific to employees and managers) and external (on the company's official website on the world wide web); and

b) in Portuguese;

III - conducting training:

a) addressing integrity content, such as those related to the code of ethics and conduct, with general evidence from program content, lists, photos, among others;

b) carried out in the last eighteen months prior to the date of publication of this Ordinance; and

c) specification of the number of employees and managers trained;

IV - the availability of an effective reporting channel:

a) with the possibility of making anonymous complaints;



b) implemented more than twelve months prior to the date of publication of this Ordinance;

c) available in Portuguese; and

d) with wide dissemination and easy access from the institutional website, even if it is outsourced;

V - the disclosure of information related to the integrity program:

a) on its institutional website; and

b) published in Portuguese, clearly and easily accessible;

VI - analysis of risks related to corruption and fraud:

a) carried out in the last twenty-four months prior to the date of publication of this Ordinance; and

b) proven by means of risk matrices, reports, reports, applied questionnaires, produced by the company or by a third party contracted for this purpose;

VII - be a regular signatory of the "Business Pact for Integrity and against Corruption" promoted by the Ethos Institute, until the closing date for registration, regardless of whether or not you are a member of the Institute;

VIII - adherence to the "Brazil Pact for Business Integrity", promoted by the Comptroller's Office-General of the Union - CGU, until the closing date for registration; and

IX - adherence to the "Collective Action Against Corruption in Agribusiness" of the UN Global Compact - Network Brazil, until the closing date for registration.

Art. 10. From the perspective of social responsibility, the company must prove:

I - certificates, issued in the CNPJ of the registered company, which prove regularity within the scope tax and labor, and valid, at least, until the date of submission of the evaluation form, namely:

a) Certificate of Debts Relating to Federal Tax Credits and the Union's Active Debt

(<https://solucoes.receita.fazenda.gov.br/Servicos/certidaointernet/PJ/EmitirPGFN>);



b) FGTS Regularity Certificate - CRF (<https://consulta.crf.caixa.gov.br/consultacrf/pages/consultaEmpregador.jsf>); and

c) Certificate of Labor Debts, issued by the Labor Court (Error! The hyperlink reference is not valid.);

II - declaration in the form provided for in Annex II, on labor violations related to the exploitation of child labor or apprenticeship, as provided for in articles 401, 403, 404, 405, 407, 409, 411, 412, 413, 415, 416, 423, 425, 426, 427, 428, 432 and 439, all of Decree-Law No. 5,452, of May 1st. of 1943;

III - statement, issued by the integrity area and duly detailed, on mitigation actions for handling the record of fines related to NR-31, in the last twenty-four months prior to the date of publication of this Ordinance or declaration of non-existence of records of fines of this nature; and

IV - Occupational Health and Safety Program - SST, implemented with periodic training, accident or illness indicators with reduction targets and evidence of continuous improvement, in accordance with relevant legislation.

Art. 11. From an environmental sustainability perspective, the company must prove:

I - Negative Certificate of Environmental Debts issued by the Brazilian Institute of the Environment and Renewable Natural Resources - IBAMA through the electronic address <https://servicos.ibama.gov.br/sicafiext/>;

II - declaration, signed by the interested party's representative, that there are no outstanding fines arising from infractions in the area of agricultural inspection, based on a consultation on the official portal of Electronic Ministry Agriculture and Livestock put middle of the address

https://extranet.agricultura.gov.br/sipe_cons/lap_consulta_boleto_sicar_cons, and the case(s) of pending issues relating to appealed fine(s) and still pending technical opinion may be excluded, provided that they are duly justified;

III - declaration of compliance with the "Regulatory Standards for Rural Work", especially in relation to Occupational Health and Safety in Agriculture, Livestock, Forestry and Forestry and Aquaculture - NR-31, as far as it applies, in whole or in part, to the activity carried out in company; and

IV - sustainability program or report with contribution to at least two of the seventeen Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the 2030 agenda (UN).

CHAPTER IV

ANALYSIS OF EVALUATION DOCUMENTS

Art. 12. Once the registration stage has been completed, the analysis process will be carried out based on the information and supporting documents sent by the company, together with the Evaluation Form.

§ 1 Any company that presents false information, data or documents, manipulates or adulterates their contents or omits relevant facts capable of impacting the assessment, whether by action or omission, will be automatically excluded from the process.

§ 2 During the analysis, the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee may request clarifications regarding the information provided by the company, as provided for in art. 13;

§ 3 In the event of the existence of derogatory facts or information related to the provisions of § 1, the company will be questioned about this information and must, within a maximum period of five days, counting from the receipt of the notification, provide the requested clarifications for evaluation by the Committee.

§ 4 Depending on the characteristics of the facts attributed to the company and the clarifications it presents, the documentation may not be evaluated and, in this case, the company will be notified of the reasons for the decision.



§ 5 For the purposes of verifying the existence, functioning and reliability of the reporting channels, tests may be carried out on these channels during the evaluation phase and the findings obtained will be used to compare the information previously provided by the company.

§ 6 An electronic perception survey regarding the application of the integrity program may be carried out with company employees, guaranteeing anonymity and confidentiality of data, in accordance with guidelines and procedures issued by the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee during the evaluation process.

Art. 13. The Executive Secretariat of the Management Committee may request clarifications or the sending of additional documents in case of doubt related to:

I - understanding of the response provided by the company in the Evaluation Form; or

II - veracity of the information and documents presented by the company.

Sole paragraph. Any company that, after requesting the clarifications referred to in Article 12, fails to prove the veracity of the information and documents submitted within the established deadline will be excluded from the evaluation process.

Art. 14. The maximum score for the Evaluation Form is one hundred points, divided between three areas, as per Annex III, as follows:

I - anti-corruption approach: fifty points;

II - focus on social responsibility: twenty-five points; and

III - focus on environmental sustainability: twenty-five points.

§ 1º The company that will be considered approved to appear on the list of award-winning companies will be the company that, cumulatively:

I - obtain a total score equal to or greater than sixty points; and

II - obtain, at least:

- a) thirty points, in the anti-corruption approach;
- b) fifteen points, focusing on social responsibility; and
- c) fifteen points, focusing on environmental sustainability.

§ 2 The score for each item is distributed as per Annex III.

Art. 15. After analyzing the integrity programs and other documents, the evaluation reports will be submitted by the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee for conclusive deliberation by the Management Committee on the approval or non-approval of the companies to be included in the list of award winners, in accordance with the criteria of this Regulation.

CHAPTER V

RECONSIDERATION AND APPEAL

Art. 16. Companies that did not achieve the minimum score may submit a request for reconsideration containing qualifications, justification and clear requests, within five business days, counting from the notification of the result.

§ 1 The request for reconsideration referred to in the caput will be analyzed by the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee, within five business days, counting from its receipt, and submitted for consideration by the Management Committee, which will deliberate on the request.

§ 2^o Upon notification of the decision on the request for reconsideration, companies will also be allowed to file an appeal within three business days of receipt, which must be addressed to the Executive Secretary of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock.

§ 3^o Once the decision has been made by the Executive Secretary, the result will be recorded by the Committee Manager.

§ 4^o It is prohibited, in the phase referred to in the caput, to attach documents that have not been presented previously.

CHAPTER VI

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE LIST OF AWARD-WINNING COMPANIES

Art. 17. Before the results are published, companies will receive the evaluation report. documentation, under the terms provided for in this Regulation.

Art. 18. The Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee will publish the list of companies approved to compose the list of award winners through the electronic address <https://www.gov.br/agricultura/pt-br/assuntos/integridade/integridade-no-setor-privado/selo-mais-integridade>.

Art. 19. The Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee will publish the evaluation report of the approved companies at the electronic address referred to in art. 18, excluding the final score, confidential information by legal definition and sensitive data indicated by the company itself.

CHAPTER VII

THE RIGHTS OF THE AWARD WINNERS

Art. 20. Companies awarded the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" will have the following rights during the period of use of the seal:

I - have your name published on the website of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock and any other websites media and advertising, or even on occasions where the award is highlighted; and

II - use the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" brand in its media, advertising and the like.

CHAPTER VIII

OBLIGATIONS OF THE AWARD WINNERS



Art. 21. Companies awarded the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" will be required to:

I - use the seal appropriately, in accordance with the Brand Manual, exclusively for institutional and promotional purposes linked to the award edition, observing the usage guidelines defined by the organizing entity;

II - refrain from any use of the seal that may mislead the public, compromise the integrity of the award or violate the principles of good faith, truthfulness and transparency;

III - maintain the criteria and standards that justified its granting, committing to communicate to the organizing entity any relevant change that may impact the maintenance of the award;

IV - not to assign, transfer or sublicense the use of the seal to third parties, in any form or pretext;

V - submit, when requested, to any verification of compliance with the continued compliance with the evaluation criteria that justified the awarding of the seal;

VI - take appropriate measures to investigate any irregularities of which it becomes aware, including by establishing internal investigation procedures, ensuring, where applicable, the accountability of employees, managers or agents involved in the practice of unethical or illegal acts; and

VII - immediately remove from its institutional and promotional materials any mention of the seal, in case it is discredited or disqualified.

Sole paragraph. Failure to comply with any of the obligations set forth in the caput may result in the revocation of the seal granted, without prejudice to other applicable sanctions, as provided for in these Regulations.

Art. 22. The companies included in the list of award winners will be responsible for ensuring the proper use of the brand.

Art. 23. Companies awarded the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" will sign the Commitment Term for Integrity, Social Responsibility and Environmental Sustainability and Appropriate Use of the Brand, according to the model to be made available by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock.

Sole Paragraph. Refusal to sign the commitment term provided for in the caput will imply non-disclosure of the company's name on the list of award winners.

CHAPTER IX

FROM THE BRAND "AGRO MAIS INTEGRIDADE" SEAL

Art. 24. The "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" brand will have a single version, as established by the Brand Manual at the electronic address <https://www.gov.br/agricultura/pt-br/assuntos/integridade/integridade-no-setor-privado/selo-mais-integridade>, with the purpose of enhancing the dissemination of the list of award-winning companies.

Sole paragraph. The trademark referred to in the caput does not grant the award-winning company any rights, guarantees or privileges, regarding the legality or suitability of the acts performed by it.

Art. 25. Only companies awarded in this edition are authorized to use the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" brand.

Sole paragraph. The authorization referred to in the caput prohibits:

I - the extension of the use of the brand to an economic group or to companies that make up the same economic group, unless all companies in the group have been approved and included in the list of award-winning companies;

II - the use of the brand by associated individual cooperatives whose documentation is not included in the registration register; and

III - the use of the brand in association with other companies that have not been approved or evaluated in the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026", even if from the same economic group.

CHAPTER X

EXCLUSION HYPOTHESES

Art. 26. The company that appears on the list of winners of the "Selo Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026" may be excluded from it in the following cases:

- I - involvement in illegal acts or failures contrary to the objectives of the award;
- II - irregularity in the use of the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025-2026 Seal" brand;
- III - failure to maintain the Assessment Requirements provided for in Chapter III; and
- IV - failure to comply with the Obligations of the Awardees provided for in Chapter VIII.

Art. 27. The Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee will take steps to investigate any of the facts referred to in art. 26.

§ 1 During the investigations, the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee may request clarification from the company, as well as obtain information through the analysis of administrative or judicial proceedings related to the facts under investigation.

§ 2 The Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee may, depending on the severity of the facts, provisionally suspend the company's right to use the "Agro Mais Integridade Seal 2025-2026" brand.

§ 3 At the end of the due diligence referred to in the caput, if the existence of errors is confirmed, the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee may, after consulting the Management Committee, exclude the company from the list of award winners and, consequently, declare the definitive loss of the right to use the "Agro Mais Integridade Seal 2025-2026" brand.

§ 4º The Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee will be responsible for communicating to the company the decision as to whether or not to exclude the right to use the brand.

CHAPTER XI

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 28. There will be no cost for those interested in obtaining the "Agro Mais Integridade 2025 Seal 2026".

Art. 29. Except in the cases provided for in this Regulation, no other type of administrative appeal of the decisions of the Management Committee.

Art. 30. The information and documents sent by companies during the registration and evaluation processes, as well as the reports resulting from the analysis of these documents and respective grades, will not be disclosed to third parties, except in the cases provided for in this Ordinance and with the express authorization of the company, as it is understood that the disclosure of such information does not serve the purpose of promotion intended by the award.

Art. 31. Companies awarded in previous editions, whose term of use of the seal brand expires in 2024 or 2025, are authorized to continue using the brand until the publication of the ordinance approving the result of this edition.

Art. 32. Companies awarded in previous editions, in which the term of use of the brand expires in 2026, they are authorized to use it until its expiration date.

Art. 33. Questions regarding interpretation and omissions must be sent by email to the Executive Secretariat of the Agro Mais Integridade Seal Management Committee at the email address integridade@agro.gov.br, so that they can be presented to the Management Committee, if applicable, for further clarification.
